### POLICY STATEMENT

Hervey Bay Netball Association is committed to ensuring consistency and transparency in practices related to the nomination and selection processes around the annual Player and Official awards.

The purpose of this document is to provide guidelines for managing nomination and selection processes related to these awards.

### PROCEDURE

#### **Determining Award Categories**

Hervey Bay Netball Association (HBNA) Management Committee are responsible for determining the amount and type of annual awards available to members. As much as possible, these awards should be consistent from year to year, however the Management Committee has the responsibility to review the relevance of these awards in line with current membership expectations.

It is recommended that at a minimum the below awards should be on offer:

- Senior Player of the Year (1 award recipient)
- Junior Player of the Year (1 award recipient)
- Players player (1 award recipient in each competition division)
- Best on Court (1 award recipient in each competition division)
- Premiers awards (1 for each player in the winning team for each division)
- Runners Up awards (1 for each player in the runners up team for each division)
- Participation awards (for all NetSetGO participants)

## Nominations for Awards

### *Senior Player of the Year*

HBNA Management Committee Members and Affiliated Clubs are entitled to submit 1 nomination each for this award. Nominations should be called at least 28 days prior to the presentation event. The nomination instructions and relevant forms should be included with this notice.

Nominations should close with enough time to arrange engraving on awards.

### *Junior Player of the Year*

HBNA Management Committee Members and Affiliated Clubs are entitled to submit 1 nomination each for this award. Nominations should be called at least 28 days prior to the presentation event. The nomination instructions and relevant forms should be included with this notice.

Nominations should close with enough time to arrange engraving on awards.

### *Outstanding Umpire of the Year*

HBNA Management Committee Members and Affiliated Clubs are entitled to submit 1 nomination each for this award. Nominations should be called at least 28 days prior to the presentation event. The nomination instructions and relevant forms should be included with this notice.

Nominations should close with enough time to arrange engraving on awards.

### *Players Player*

Throughout the season, teams are required to submit players player votes at the conclusion of each competition round. These votes are collated at the conclusion of the competition rounds, and the award recipient for each division is determined.

The HBNA Management Committee are responsible for determining the most appropriate method of scoring the votes, but typically a 'points' system will be utilised whereby each team are required to identify a player on the opposition team to award 2 points, and a player on the opposition team to award 1 point. This activity occurs after each game during the competition rounds.

### *Best on Court*

At the conclusion of each Grandfinal match, the umpires allocated to that match are required to collaborate and identify a player that participated in the match to be the recipient for this award.

### Assessing Award Nominations

#### *Senior Player of the Year*

HBNA Management Committee are responsible for determining who should be charged with responsibility for assessing nominees. Typically assessment of nominees is tasked to one of the following groups:

- HBNA Management Committee
- HBNA Life Members

Assessment should be based on information provided in the nomination, and attributes of the nominee (in the year nominated) should be weighted in a systematic point system as follows:

### *Junior Player of the Year*

HBNA Rep umpire	10	Umpiring at a rep level within the region/zone
HBNA Rep assistant coach	10	Coaching at a rep level within the region/zone

Club manager	5	Managing at a club level

Members and Affiliated Clubs are entitled to submit 1 nomination for this award. Nominations should be called at least 28 days prior to the presentation event. Nominations should close with enough time to arrange engraving on awards.

### In the event of a tie

In instances where multiple nominees accumulate the same number of points, further consideration should occur to determine the final recipient.

#### *Senior Player of the Year*

The group tasked with assessing these award nominees should consider other information provided in the nomination, such as evidence of sportsmanship and length of service. Effort should be made to identify a 'point of difference' between the tied nominees.

In the event that no 'point of difference' can be identified, the members of the group tasked with assessing the nominees are required to hold a vote to determine the final recipient.

#### *Junior Player of the Year*

The group tasked with assessing these award nominees should consider other information provided in the nomination, such as evidence of sportsmanship and length of service. Effort should be made to identify a 'point of difference' between the tied nominees.

In the event that no 'point of difference' can be identified, the members of the group tasked with assessing the nominees are required to hold a vote to determine the final recipient.

### *Outstanding Umpire of the Year*

In the event that no 'point of difference' can be identified, the members of the group tasked with assessing the nominees are required to hold a vote to determine the final recipient.

### *Players Player*

In the event of tied nominees, HBNA Management Committee are required to hold a vote to determine the final recipient.
